Understand what is robbing you of credibility and authority.

128. Figure out how to multiply money without anyone else's effort. Figure out how to capture and multiply attention without any incremental cost to you. Figure out how to return time to the masses. Learn how to influence others so they can behave and act in alignment with what you want. This is how you become a billionaire.
129. Advanced people always do the basics. All scaling is just doing what you were doing before, just more of it. It's not complex, it is just scaling.
130. You have the ability to be resourceful for somebody else, but not for you. If you have to pay your rent and payroll tomorrow and you don't have the money, you think differently. So instead of choosing a date in the future to work, choose today.
131. Short term sacrifice for long term achievement is the equation for success.
132. You cannot lose if you do not quit.
133. Confidence is self delusion. As long as you're not fudging your numbers, then of course you're fucking certain. Confidence tries to make up for what you don't have evidence for.



134. You have to re-learn to say no. When your business grows, you will be presented deals that you don't need but are more appealing than the ones you already learned to say no to.
135. Replicate before you iterate. Copy what works before you make it your own.
136. Use different tonalities for making different points. Low for importance. High for making and obvious statement.
137. If you want to be in the 1%, stop caring about what the 99% are doing. You have to be comfortable with not doing what everyone else is doing.
138. When you give enough, you will start getting without even asking for anything.
139. There is a reason that high level entrepreneurs live the way they do. Dedicate time in the morning to just work with no meetings. Then work and take meetings if needed in the afternoon. Then go to bed at a consistent time.
140. Habit stacking - pair a habit that you don't want to do with a habit that you do want to do. If you can add the habit without adding the time, you make it convenient to do the thing.
141. Sometimes just adding cost to the prices works. When something becomes more expensive, people perceive its value in a higher way.
142. What could you do to destroy your business? Then do the opposite of that.
143. Above all else you need to protect your headspace. It makes sense to buy your time back if you can make more money in that amount of time than the cost of buying it back.
144. If you can increase the profit of your business, then there will be a multiple that is added to the value of the business. The value of the business that was increased is tax free. You don't get rich off of the income, but the growth of the equities that grow tax free.
145. You will be dead in 3 generations and so will the people that judge you. Do you really care?
146. Your ability to earn money to provide value to the marketplace and solve problems for other people is how you will make money. There is the value of the problem you are solving, and then there is what you charge to solve the problem. The gap between the two is the percentage that you can put in your pocket.
147. The best investment vehicle to yield returns is yourself. Your earning capacity is what will generate wealth. Say you save 25K/year, that is 2K/month that you can spend on education/mentorships/workshops to increase your capacity to solve problems and therefore earn. No one person or course will teach you everything. What's cooler than buying one course/mentorship is buying them all, then you will know that everybody knows. You should invest in the S&ME instead of the S&P.
148. Skills stack exponentially. Example - video + editing + social media + messaging + copywriting + branding + management + operations + leadership. Now you're a CMO getting paid exponentially more than a videographer.
149. The easiest way to get someone's phone number - would it be totally overstepping for me to ask for your number so we can exchange info?
150. While starting a business, you need to promote - know who you're trying to reach, know what media you're going to use (text, email, video), what activities do you need to do to reach them (either 1 on 1 or make a media post).

151. You can either have your ego based on how you look to everyone, or you can have your ego based on the freedom that you feel.
152. The billion dollar skill is being able to accurately judge people's talent and knowing how to lead a team of A-players. There is a team that can get you anywhere you want, but are they going to want to work for you?
153. When you are trying to upsell - "you don't want anything else do you?" - if they say no they that implies that they want what you have already shown them. They say yes by saying no.
154. If people have to treat you a certain way for you to feel happy, then your happiness is in their hands. How we manage the circumstances or conditions that come to us dictates how our life turns out. When something bothers you, observe it, question why it is bad, and question what it would look like if it were good. Use volume and time. What would it look like if it were worse? What would it look like if it were worse all the time? 100 or 10000 years out, how much is this going to matter? Something only affects you if you deem it to be meaningful.
155. When you need to announce something to your company and get people to do something that they don't want to do - you guys are amazing, 90% of you have already filled this out, if you haven't done it please get it done by the end of the day because your the stragglers and you know who you are, so go get that done. - people want to be part of the majority. You want to make them feel like part of the minority and that they don't want to be in the minority.
156. Use ghost products. list products on your menu that you stock less or don't stock in inventory - "you don't need this one, you can probably get a cheaper version somewhere else, but what you really need is this and this." - people will trust you more if you try to save them money up front in another way. You show your intention of trying to help the prospect.
157. You should spend all the money that you have to acquire skills until you can't spend money on acquiring skills anymore. Normally you can't stop spending money on skills, you just have to do it differently - making donations to charities in the hundreds of thousands of dollars to get access to the guys on the boards of the charities that can afford to donate hundreds of millions of dollars to see what they know and learn faster.
158. If you run out of stock of a product, just cover with "you can actually get this cheaper from here, but you do need this and this" so you still sell what you normally sell. If you believe in the stuff that you sell, you can create an environment where someone will trust you faster by giving them a reason to trust you. You acted in their self-interest rather than your own so they can feel like your not trying to take advantage of them.
159. The only way to learn a skill is through volume - the best book on selling is to actually sell stuff alot. 100X the effort you get 100X the result. Sometimes its great to be an employee because it gives you the opportunity to build the skills to do what you want to do eventually.
160. The only way to not have money own you is to know how to generate it and then you can respect it for what it is, know its limitations and know what you can use it for.
161. You might not have low testosterone. You might just be incredibly receptive to testosterone so you don't need much.

162. The biggest mistake salesmen make is that they want to keep selling after they have already closed (the prospect says yes). You will sell yourself out of a deal. Just shut the fuck up and get the credit card.
163. If you want to do a deal bad enough, you'll do a bad deal.
164. If you have to motivate employees, they are not worth having.
165. Man's greatest burden is unfulfilled potential.
166. Always have big margins. You only make money if you have big margins
167. If your not first, you have to be different
168. You only have two times to make a first impression. One, when I look at you. Two, when you open your mouth.
169. There is no protecting people, there is only making them stronger. It is not the job of the parents to protect their children, but instead to expose their children to the world in a controlled manner.
170. Different people play by different rules because they have earned the right to do so.
171. You should make your children socially desirable by the age of four. You want other children to be welcoming and want to play with your kid, and you want adults to be happy to see your kid and treat them properly.
